Rutland Middle School Dress Code

School Colors:

Rutland – Forest Green, Orange, White, Black and Grey

PANTS OR SKIRTS:

- Plain khaki, black or blue pants or shorts, or plain khaki, black or blue skirts.
- No rips, frays or holes in pants, shorts or skirts.
- No tights, yoga pants, jogging pants/shorts or warm up pants/shorts.
- Jeans and cargo pants/shorts are not allowed. (However, jeans are permitted on days designated by the principal.)
- Pants must be of appropriate size, worn as designed and of ankle length. Pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed.
- Skirts/shorts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee.
- Skirts cannot have any slits or openings.

SHIRTS:

- School color polo shirts.
- Shirts can be long sleeve or short sleeve.
- Polo shirts must have a collar.
- School spirit wear t-shirts are the only t-shirts allowed. Plain t-shirts are not permitted.
- No rips, holes, or offensive print on shirts.
- Hoodies will be allowed but hoods cannot be worn.
- Hoodies must have a dress code appropriate shirt underneath.

SHOES and SOCKS:

- All shoes must have closed toes and heels.
- No Croc's, flip flops or slides.
- Tennis shoes with properly sized and secured.
- Soft soled shoes (no heels allowed).

HEADWEAR/ELECTRONICS

- No hats, stocking caps or skull caps are to be worn in the building.
- No hoods are to be worn in the building.
- No bandanas are to be worn as headbands.
- Earbuds and Headphones are to be removed immediately upon entering the building.

JEWELRY:

- Gold or Silver Jewelry Standard-sized Only.
- No bandanas worn in any fashion.

Note:

- No Picks or rat tailed combs are permitted.
- All other items, which in the judgment of the principal (designee), disrupt or distract from the teaching and learning process will not be allowed.
